

General

Ensure that banner is taught and free of wrinkles. Keep the banner clean at all times. This presents professionalism to your clientele. Do not leave the banner out in high winds.

Standard Installation

Use rubber tension cords (hockey straps) as these help absorb wind loading which will aid in preventing damage to your banner. Use sufficient straps to remove wrinkles. On larger banners you may need to double up the straps. If possible install banner against a wall or fence. All eyelets should be used to help support the banner.

Across road installations

We recommend that you use purpose build heavy duty banners with 8mm ropes.

Cleaning

Most banners can be cleaned with a mild detergent. If stained drop banner into Signs Plus for advise.

Storage

Banners must be completely dry before storage. Always roll banners DO NOT FOLD. (Roll around a cardboard tube) If banner has vinyl lettering always roll with vinyl lettering to the outside. Store in a cool dry area. Do not stack things on top of stored banners.

By following these simple instructions your banner will give many years of service
